DAY 1 Singapore ✈ Incheon

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport and begin your holiday with a pleasant flight to Seoul.

DAY 2 Incheon - Gyeongsangbuk-Do - Daegu

- Meal on Board, Lunch: *Andong Jimdak*, Dinner: *Shabu Shabu Buffet* -

Upon arrival, meet and greet by our local representative. Proceed to the UNESCO World Heritage - **Andong Hahoe Folk Village**. It is a traditional village from the Joseon Dynasty. Thereafter, visit **DongSeongRo Shopping Street**, one of the busiest shopping street in Daegu where you will be able to find a lot of fashion apparels for everyone.

DAY 3 Daegu - Busan

- Hotel Breakfast, Lunch: *Pork Bulgogi*, Dinner: *Fish Soup Stew* -

This morning, visit **Cheongdo Wine Tunnel**. The wine tunnel is perfect for aging persimmon wine which is a local specialty. Next, proceed to **Haedong Yonggungsa Temple** build in 1376 next to the seaside with a spectacular view. Thereafter, proceed to **APEC House** the most beautiful place among the meeting places where the 2005 APEC meeting was held. Drive pass **Gwanganli Bridge** to see the spectacular and romantic atmosphere beautiful lighting that changes with the season. Next, visit **Bay 101** which is a beautiful place to view nightscape in Busan City.

DAY 4 Busan

- Breakfast, Lunch: *Jagalchi Buffet*, Dinner: *Gamja-Tang* -

The highlight of today is visit to **Santorini Village** with a panoramic view of the village famous for its brightly coloured terrace houses spread across the face of a steep hill looking out to the sea. Continue to visit **Graffiti Street**, which is a hub for artists and arts students who constantly create projects to be exhibited at the village. Thereafter, visit **Jagalchi Fish Market**, which is Korea's largest seafood market and is where you can see the lifestyle of the indigenous Busan natives. Next, visit the **International Market** and **BIFF Square** that promotes the advancement of Korea's film industry, and also contributed to Busan's newly transformed district as an international cultural tourist city. Lastly, from the 365-meter long **Songdo Skywalk** over the blue ocean, you can enjoy the magnificent view around.

DAY 5 Busan - Mount Daedun - Gyeonggi-Do Region

- Hotel Breakfast, Lunch: *Mushroom Steamboat*, Dinner: *BBQ Pork* -

After breakfast, transfer to **Mt Daedun** for a **Cable Car** (subject to weather conditions) ride up Korea's most beautiful mountain in the Central region with all kinds of rock formations. Here, you can experience walking across a **suspension bridge** among the clouds where you can find a quaint little stone temple at the other end. Continue for **fruit picking session** (seasonal).

DAY 6 Gyeonggi-Do Region - Seoul

- Hotel Breakfast, Lunch: Chicken on Hotplate,
Dinner: 8 Colour Samgyeopsal BBQ -

This morning immerse yourself in the beautiful cultural village at **Petite France**. Be sure to explore the beautiful French-style buildings and visit the memorial hall dedicated to Saint-Exupery, the author of The Little Prince! Next, continue to **Nami Island**; this island is the location where many scenes from the famous drama, Winter Sonata, were shot. Stroll along the beautiful Road of Redwood filled with chestnut trees, authentic cottages and a beautiful lake. Thereafter, proceed to **Dongdaemun Market**, a great shopping paradise where traditional open-air markets stand alongside modern shopping malls with fashionable clothing and accessories selling at inexpensive prices.

DAY 7 Seoul

- Hotel Breakfast, Lunch: Ginseng Chicken Soup + Abalone, Dinner: KRW10,000 Voucher -
Our Seoul city sightseeing will allow all to view the grandeur of the 40-acre **Gyeongbok Palace**, you can experience trying on the traditional Korean costume - **The Hanbok**. Drive pass the **Presidential Blue House**, the official home of South Korea's president. En route, stop at the **Korean Taekuk Ginseng Gallery** and **Korean Cosmetics Showroom** where Korea-manufactured beauty products are available at affordable prices. Next, proceed to **Healthy Liver Showroom**, well-known for its health products such as cordyceps and huganbao miracle tonic. Continue to the DFS, thereafter enjoy more shopping sensations in **Myeongdong**, one of Seoul's main shopping and tourism districts.

Note: A levy of S\$200 or KRW185,000 will be collected from each passenger who leaves the Seoul City tour group.

DAY 8 Seoul - Incheon ✈ Singapore

- Hotel Breakfast, Meal on Board -

After breakfast, drive to **Hongik University Street**, is a vibrant and youthful street. It is popular for music, street art, galleries, cafes, and fashionable shops. Enjoy last minute shopping at the **Korean Local Product Convenience Store**, offering locally manufactured goodies such as ginseng sweets, kimchi, seaweeds, honey citron tea, instant ramen, souvenirs, etc. You will be transferred to the airport for the flight back to Singapore.
