DAY 1

Singapore ✈ Melbourne

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport and begin your holiday with a pleasant flight to **Melbourne**.

DAY 2

Melbourne

- *Meal on Board, Lunch -*

Upon arrival, begin your **city tour** by driving past the **Melbourne Arts Precinct**. Next, cross the **Princes Bridge** spanning from the **Yarra River** to the **Federation Square** and see **St Patrick's Cathedral**, **Flinders Street Station** and **Chinatown**. See the **City Circle Tram** in motion along the way and view the **Parliament House**,

Note:

1. In the event of local religious festivals, unforeseen circumstances and/or bad weather conditions, the sequence of the itinerary may be changed or altered. Alternative attractions will be substituted without prior notice and/or at short notice in order to ensure a smoother journey and tour. Tour groups may be merged.

4. Minimum group size of 16 passengers is required for a confirmed departure. Group size of 15 and below will solely be at the discretion of ASA Holidays and passengers need to accept the arrangement.
5. Every group of 26 passengers will have a Singapore tour manager to accompany the tour throughout.
6. In the event that there is no tour manager, tickets for the attractions will have to be collected by the passengers at the respective attractions. Passengers will be required to check in to hotels themselves and will have to use their own credit card or cash as guarantors against any expenses incurred in their own rooms.
7. A driver-guide may be arranged for selected Australia Tour groups. The Driver-guide's duty is to drive and give commentary on the coach. They do not accompany the group to attractions or assist to collect attractions tickets; while a driver's duty is only to drive the passengers around.



6D Melbourne & Tesselaar Tulip Festival (AMEL6T)

Shrine of Remembrance and **Fitzroy Gardens**. Continue visit to the only surviving 19th-century market in the CBD, the **Queen Victoria Market*** (open daily except for Monday, Wednesday and Public Holidays). Eat, shop, explore and discover your way through the iconic food halls and heritage sheds where there are fresh local produce, handicrafts, souvenirs, an assortment of cooked food, pastries, chocolates and many more or simply soak up the atmosphere of the largest open-air market in the Southern Hemisphere. Next, make a photo stop at the colourful **Brighton Bathing Boxes**.

Note: If Queen Victoria Market is closed. It will be replaced by South Wharf Direct Factory Outlets (DFO). It may also be changed to another day which the market is open.

DAY 3

Melbourne - Phillip Island - Melbourne

- *Breakfast, Homestead Lunch, Half Lobster Dinner -*

Start the day with a visit to **Warrook Cattle Farm**, a working cattle farm. Learn more about **farm activities** like sheep shearing, cow milking, whip cracking, sheep dogs demonstrations and learn how wool is graded. Enjoy patting and feeding kangaroos. Next, proceed to **Panny's Chocolate Factory** and learn how chocolates are made and get the chance to make your own chocolates on the spot. Continue to the award winning **A Maze 'N Things** to enjoy unique and interactive puzzles, games and illusions. Next, proceed to witness the famous **Penguin Parade**.

Note: Please remember to bring along warm clothing as it will be cold at night.

DAY 4

Melbourne - Dandenong Ranges - Yarra Valley - Melbourne

- *Breakfast, Winery Western Lunch -*

Begin your day by journeying into the **Dandenong Ranges** to visit **Tesselaar Tulip Farm** and enjoy the **Tesselaar Tulip Festival** (Sep 14 - Oct 13). Be amazed by the beauty of a million Tulips across 25 acres of farmland. Next, climb aboard Australia's oldest steam train - **Puffing Billy** and travel through the towering mountain ash and beautiful lush fern gullies. Continue to **Rochford Winery** in picturesque **Yarra Valley** to enjoy your lunch and to experience **wine tasting**. Next, visit **Healesville Wildlife Sanctuary** and get up-close to over 200 species of Australian animals including koalas, kangaroos, emus, wombats, dingoes and platypus.

DAY 5
