### Day 1: Singapore — Chengdu (Meal on Board)

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport for your flight to Chengdu, provincial capital of Sichuan. Upon arrival, transfer to hotel for check in.

### Day 2: Chengdu — Jiuzhaigou (B/L/D)

Proceed to Jiuzhaigou Scenic Area & along the way enjoy the Tibetan & Qiang minority ethnic customs. **Diexihaizi** (Diexi Lake) is a landslide dam-created lake formed in the 1933 Diexi earthquake and covers 3.5 square kilometres. Tonight check in to Jiuzhaigou Hotel.

### Day 3: Jiuzhaigou Scenic Area (B/L/D)

**Jiuzhaigou Scenic Area (with Public Green Battery Car)**, renowned throughout the world as a fairyland. The most famous attractions are the Shuzhengqun Gully, Zechazhu Gully and Rize Gully; these three gullies form the letter 'Y'. Jiuzhaigou is so named because the area was originally home to nine Tibetan tribal stockades. *(Jiuzhaigou Scenic Area Recovery and reconstruction work is still in progress, not fully open to visitors, therefore, can only visit the current scenic spots temporarily open)*

### Day 4: Jiuzhaigou — Maoxian (B/L/D)

Proceed to Maoxian and pass by **Songpan Ancient Town**. Continue to **Mounigou Scenic Area**, listed as the World Biosphere Reserve, World Natural Heritage as well as the Green Globe 21 of UN. Its spectacular mountain scenery, large waterfall and the surrounding culture combine to create an attractive landscape.

### Day 5: Maoxian — Leshan — Mt.Emei (B/L/D)

After breakfast visit **Qiang Village**, the Qiang People today are mountain dwellers. A fortress village, zhai 寨, composed of 30 to 100 households, in general, is the basic social unit beyond

the household. An average of two to five fortress villages in a small valley along a mountain stream, known in local Chinese as gou 沟, make up a village cluster (cun 村).. Next, proceed to

**Leshan Giant Buddha (boat ride).** The Giant Buddha is located on the western slope of Xiluan Peak of Lingyun Hill. It is a sitting stone sculpture statue of Grand Buddha.

**Day 6: Mt.Emei — Chengdu (B/L/D)**

**Mt. Emei**, is one of the four sacred Buddhist Mountains in China. Ever since the introduction of Buddhism into China in the 1st century AD, Buddhist buildings have been built on the mountain. Now there are more than one hundred temples and monasteries. Visit **BaoGuo Temple** and **Fuhu Temple**. **Huanglongxi Ancient Town(Additional Tour)**, the uniqueness is its ancient streets, trees, temples, wharves and heritage houses displaying time-honoured and unadorned folk customs

**Day 7: Chengdu (B/L)**

Visit **Chengdu Research Base of Giant Panda Breeding**. You will take a close look at these cute animals playing in the park and observe their inhabiting environment and behaviours. **“Width Alley”**, is one of Chengdu has a long history of business cards, where you can touch history here left traces, but also to appreciate the Chengdu Let's original flavor of the mayonnaise leisure lifestyle, into the alley width, into the most Chengdu, the world's oldest and most fashionable old Chengdu. Thereafter, free shopping at Chengdu famous **Chunxi Pedestrian street**.

**Day 8: Chengdu — Singapore (B)**

After breakfast, free at your own leisure until airport transfer for your flight back to Singapore.
