Day 1 : Singapore/Shanghai/Suzhou (D)

Set off from Changi International Airport to Shanghai Pudong Airport. Upon arrival proceed to Suzhou, view Suzhou Bird's Nest from outside. then visit **Shantang Street**, an ancient riverside pedestrian road in northwest Suzhou, is very popular with tourists. it winds northwest on the northern bank of the Shantang River, and ends at scenic Tiger Hill. It extends about 2.2 miles (seven li), hence the name 'Seven-Li Shantang'.

Day 2 : Suzhou/Nanjing (B/L)

After breakfast, we will visit **Lion Forest Park**. There are multitude of bamboos and a great number of queer stones which look like lions and therefore, the park was named so. Thereafter visit **Grand Bao'en Temple**, The Porcelain Tower of Nanjing part of the former Bao'en Temple is a historical site located on the south bank of external Qinhuai River in Nanjing, China. It was a pagoda constructed in the 15th century during the Ming Dynasty, but was mostly destroyed in the 19th century during the course of the Taiping Rebellion.. At night, we will visit the biggest traditional ancient street market in China, **Fuzimiao** and enjoy the night scenery of the Qinhuai River.

Day 3: Nanjing/Wuxi (B/L/D)

After breakfast, visit The **Ming Great Wall of Nanjing**. The Ming Great Wall was 35 kilometers long. It was considered to be one of the longest city walls in the world. Today about 25 kilometers are still intact with the following six sections being opened to the public After lunch proceed to Wuxi, visit **Yuantouzhu**, called Turtle Head Island, is endowed with gorgeous natural scenery of Taihu Lake, with green hills and clear water. The gardens of Yuantouzhu were first constructed in the late nineteenth century. The bridges and pavilions now are standing at Yuantouzhu date from that time. Thereafter, visit **Huishan Ancient Town**, which has been included in the World Heritage Tentative List. + Travel Insurance: \$ _____

Day 4 : Wuxi/Hangzhou (B/L/D)

After breakfast, drive to **Hangzhou**, boat ride on **Jinghang Grand Canal**. The Grand Canal, known as the Beijing–Hangzhou Grand Canal, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is the longest as well as one of the oldest canal or artificial river in the world and a famous tourist destination. Starting at Beijing, it passes through Tianjin and the provinces of Hebei, Shandong, Jiangsu and Zhejiang to the city of Hangzhou, linking the Yellow River and Yangtze River. Thereafter, experience **DIY mask** by yourself.

Day 5 : Hangzhou/Nanxun/Shanghai (B/L/D)

After breakfast, we will visit **Huagang Guanyu** - Viewing Fish at Flowers Harbor is one of ten top classic Views of Hangzhou West Lake highlighted with flowers, harbour and fishes. After lunch proceed to Waterside **Nanxun**, It is thanks to this that Nanxun has managed to retain its original features and traditional culture. It is recognized as the most authentic and tranquil town,

Day 6 Shanghai (B/L/D)

Pay a visit to **Shanghai World Financial Center(100 Floors)** is built on 29th Aug 2008, 492 meters high, and it's the highest flat top building in the world. Next, visit **The Bund(Wai Tan)**. The Bund is a mile-long stretch of waterfront promenade along the Huangpu River. To the west of this stretch stand 52 buildings of various architectural styles, including Gothic, baroque, and neoclassical styles. It is often referred to as "the museum of buildings". Then, visit **Chenghuangmiao** Business District, a must-visit for tourists. It is a good spot to taste the local snacks of Shanghai and other places in China. After dinner visit **Tianzifang** for shopping, which is also the characteristic street.

Day 7 : Shanghai (B)

After breakfast all day free activity. (Lunch & Dinner, Sites and Tour Guide not included)

Day 8 : Shanghai/Singapore (B)

After breakfast, free leisure at your own, till transfer to airport to take a flight back to **Singapore**.
