Day 1

SINGAPORE → MELBOURNE

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport and begin your holiday with a pleasant flight to **Melbourne**, Capital city of Victoria.

Day 2

MELBOURNE

(Meal on Board, Lunch)

Upon arrival, begin your **city tour** by driving pass the Arts Centre Melbourne, which consists of a complex of theatres and concert halls in the **Melbourne Arts Precinct**. Next, cross the **Princes Bridge** spanning from the **Yarra River** to the **Federation Square** and see **St Patrick's Cathedral**, **Flinders Street Station** and **Chinatown**. See the **City Circle Tram** in motion along the way and view the **Parliament House**, **Shrine of Remembrance** and **Fitzroy Gardens**. Continue visit to the only surviving 19th-century market in the CBD, the **Queen Victoria Market*** (open daily except for Monday, Wednesday and Public Holidays). Eat, shop, explore and discover your way through the iconic food halls and heritage sheds where there are fresh local produce, handicrafts, souvenirs, an assortment of cooked food, pastries, cheese, bread, chocolates and many more or simply soak up the atmosphere of the largest open-air market in the Southern Hemisphere. Next, make a photo stop at the colourful **Brighton Bathing Boxes**.

Note: If Queen Victoria Market is closed. It will be replaced by South Wharf Direct Factory Outlets (DFO). It may also be changed to another day which market is open.

Day 3

MELBOURNE – MORNINGTON PENINSULA – MELBOURNE

(Breakfast / Dinner)

After breakfast, depart for **Mornington Peninsula**. Proceed to a local **Strawberry Farm**. Upon arrival, experience the fun of **strawberry picking** (From November to April). Continue to **Ashcombe Maze** and **Lavender Gardens** to explore Australia's oldest and largest hedge maze as well as the lavender gardens.

Day 4

MELBOURNE – DANDENONG RANGES – YARRA VALLEY – MELBOURNE

(Breakfast, Winery Western Lunch)

Begin a fun-filled day by journeying into the **Dandenong Ranges**. Climb aboard Australia's oldest steam train - **Puffing Billy** and travel through the towering mountain ash and beautiful lush fern gullies. Continue to **Rochford Winery** in picturesque **Yarra Valley** to enjoy your lunch and to experience **wine tasting**. Next, visit **Healesville Wildlife Sanctuary** and get up-close to over 200 species of Australian animals including koalas, kangaroos, emus, wombats, dingoes and platypus.



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Day 5

MELBOURNE – PHILLIP ISLAND – MELBOURNE

(Breakfast, Homestead Lunch, Western Dinner)

Start the day with a visit to **Warrook Cattle Farm**, a working cattle farm. Embark on an educational, enriching, fun experience and learn more about **farm activities** like sheep shearing which is done in a historical shearing shed built in the 1887. There are also cow milking, whip cracking as well as sheep dogs demonstrations and learn how wool is graded. Enjoy the opportunity to pat and feed kangaroos. Next, proceed to **Panny's Chocolate Factory** and learn how chocolates are made and get the chance to make your own chocolates on the spot. Continue to the award winning **A Maze'N Things** to enjoy unique and interactive puzzles, games and illusions as well as experience the most exciting and extensive magical attraction at Magic Manor where you can explore the secret quarters of a magician. Next, proceed to witness the famous **Penguin Parade**.
